MARATHON course - 100 km with 3260 m elevation gain


ENDURANCE course - 76 km with 2400 m elevation gain

CLASSIC course - 44 km with 1485 m elevation gain

The route will be marked with specific banners and signs will be placed with specific technical information (descents, curves, refreshments, etc.) and related to the mileage covered (km missing to the finish).

At the beginning of the most challenging and important climbs there will be a sign indicating the characteristics of the climb (elevation gain, gradient, length).

Please note: full signage will be available only during the race weekend.







General information

Departure and starting grids

The access to the grid zone is from behind the starting lane, from the intersection of Via Carlo Manni and Via Lungo Viola.

The starts, based on the number of registered participants, will be done in 8-minute intervals of each other.

The allocation of grids (bibs) is based on the actual meritocracy and competitiveness of the participants (National Ranking - times AVBM editions 2018/2021/2022/2023 - and more emblazoned races (BMW Hero sudtirol Dolomites, Dolomiti Superbike, etc.) this is for more fluidity and safety throughout the course.

MARATHON, entrance from h 7:00 a.m. - PINK BIB ELITE GRID: num. 1-75, FIRST GRID: num. 75-220; SECOND GRID: num. 220-421;

ENDURANCE, entry from h 9:00 a.m. - BLUE BIB. FIRST GRID: num. 2001-2100; SECOND GRID: num. 2101-2350.

CLASSIC, entrance from h 11:00 a.m. - YELLOW BIB.

FIRST GRID: num. 4001-4020; SECOND GRID: num. 4021-4080;

THIRD GRID: num. 4081-4200.

Gates and closing time

Marathon 100 km - start 1st group 7:30 a.m. - 2nd group 7:38 a.m. - 3rd group 7:46 a.m.

- Boron Gate: km 82 4:45 p.m. (8h50' at 9.22 km/h)

Gate closing time was set based on the departure of the 3rd group at 7:46 am.

Endurance km 76 - start 1st group 9.30 am - 2nd group 9.38 am

- Pian dell'Acqua Decauville gate: km 42 hrs 15.00 (5h30' at 7.63 km/h)
- Boron Gate: km 58 4:45 p.m. (7h10' at 8.09 km/h)

Gate closing time was set based on the departure of the 2nd group at 9:46 am.



Classic 44 km - departure 1st group 11.20 am

Boron gate: km 26 4:45 p.m.

There will be two vehicles available for the recovery of athletes in mechanical or other difficulties.

Timekeeping and chip

Timing will be done by EvoData Srl with technology based on the use of the OneChip. Each participant will be required to have a valid personal chip or a daily rental chip. The following types of chips can be used: Cycling and MTB 2024-enabled personal OneChip One DailyChip rental for the day.

- Chips and/or related qualifiers can be purchased at shop.endu.net or at the "Chip Point" of the race;
- The DailyChip can only be rented at the race's Chip Point for €5.00 with a €10.00 deposit. The deposit, minus the rental cost, will be refunded upon the return of the chip, which must be done at the Chip Point within 15 minutes after the race ends;
- Other types of chips not expressly indicated are not usable;
- Failure to use the chip or incorrect use of the chip will result in not being included in the ranking and not having the time recorded.

Timekeeping stations

They will be set up at the start, finish and along the two routes. The management of the controls will be carried out by authorized personnel. Those who anticipate the start or take the start without performing the start control will be excluded from the final classification and sanctioned according to F.C.I. regulations.





Race pack and bib collection

The race bib is strictly personal, cannot be tampered with and is non-transferable.


After the license has been verified, the bib number, bike number, and race pack can be picked up, upon presentation of the registration confirmation email and valid ID, at the Multipurpose Center in Rasin locality, municipality of Valdidentro (SO), on the following days and times:

• Friday, July 26, 2024, from 09:00 to 19:00 hours Saturday, July 27, 2024, from 06:00 am to 09:00 a.m. - by 6.30 am for Marathon route, by 8.30 am for Endurance route, by 9.00 am for Classic route

The race pack may also be picked up by a third person with a written proxy, a letter of confirmation from the proxy and a photocopy of a valid ID.

The bib number placed on the left side and the bike number must be obligatorily worn for the recognition of the athlete. The front number must be mounted prominently on the handlebars of one's bicycle, under penalty of exclusion from the time classification.

In addition, there will also be a bag deposit service to keep one's belongings safe during the race.




Food Courts

Pizzocchero party

At the end of the race, athletes can refresh themselves with an appetizing banquet of Valtellina specialties: pizzoccheri, pasta, cheese, bresaola, and desserts. It will be set up at the Alta Valtellina Bike Village starting at 12 a.m. on Saturday, July 27, 2024, with the possibility for supporters to participate as well by purchasing a dedicated ticket.

Health care and mechanical assistance

For health care, it is provided for the use of ambulances with doctors and nurses, fixed First Aid points including a permanent one in the finish area, mobile Radio Rescue service.

A mechanical assistance service will be positioned in the start/finish area. Along the route will be placed nr. 4 reserved areas for refueling and authorized technical assistance managed by the teams: they will be clearly indicated and numbered, closed to the public and only authorized personnel will have access to them.

Rules for the protection of the environment

Nature is the host of the race; we are in the Stelvio National Park. Do not leave trash along the route.

It is strictly forbidden to litter along the trail. Garbage should be thrown into the bins placed after the refreshment stations. Failure to follow the rules will result in immediate disqualification.





Rights and duties of partecipants

Participation in the Alta Valtellina Bike Marathon takes place at one's own risk. By registering (including at the hands of third parties) the competitor waives any claims, including those of third parties, against the organizing committee and all natural and legal persons of other organizations involved in the event. In addition, by registration the competitor declares that he/she is properly trained, to cope with the effort required.

Participants should be aware of the following rights and duties:

- · attach to the handlebars the number and chip provided by the organization
- the bib number may not be changed or in any way altered
- use the approved hard helmet and fastened for the duration of the race
- compulsorily respect the highway code in road passages
- participants stopped at the maximum time gates must hand over their bib to the gate manager
- those who have not entered the grid 10 (ten) minutes before the start are automatically placed in the last starting grid
- · it is mandatory to bring a puncture repair kit with you to the race
- it is recommended to bring along some spare clothing and a cape in case of bad weather
- slower competitors must immediately give way to those that are overtaking
- sections with low visibility must be approached with caution
- it is mandatory to stop and repair damage at visible points outside the race course
- runners leaving the race must give notice to the first control officer on the course and at the finish line
- · changing lanes is no longer allowed in the finish area
- violation of these rules will result in disqualification

And for you who complete the **Alta Valtellina Bike Marathon**, an exclusive finisher's medal awaits you at the finish line, made from recycled wood sourced from sustainable sources, renewable energy, and zero-emission inks.
